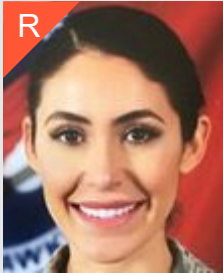

Background

An Air Force veteran from southern California, Luna aims to represent Hispanic voices in Congress

A second-generation Mexican immigrant raised by a single mother, Luna recalls struggling at a young age in Santa Ana, California, and experiencing formative events including being victim of an armed robbery and witnessing a gang shooting

Served in the Air Force for five years before attending the University of West Florida, earning a bachelor's degree in biology; credits the opportunity to serve in the military for enabling her to provide for her family

Driven to pursue politics in 2016 due to sex trafficking concerns at the border, Luna was initially set to attend medical school but opted to volunteer with Our Rescue and Veterans for Child Rescue instead

In 2018, Luna started working as the director of Hispanic engagement for Turning Point USA, a conservative advocacy organization that focuses on youth education; left Turning Point when she joined PragerU, another conservative advocacy group, as the chair of Hispanic initiatives in 2019
